



Monitoring, Reviewing and Evaluating CEIAG

At Portland our vision is to provide aspirational opportunities and guidance to prepare our students for life beyond school.

Measuring the impact of CEIAG is carried by a range of means:

- Moderation of student learning plans and CEIAG targets
- Ongoing staff CPD on how to deliver a bespoke SEND scheme of work
- Scrutiny of planning and student work
- Sixth form programme of study evaluation informs of next steps
- Collation of student questionnaires and mentoring sessions to feedback on guidance and opportunities
- Maintained database of which students are accessing enterprise, work-relating learning and work experience placements, including the skills they are expected to be practising
- Record of guidance interviews and any follow up required
- CEIAG updates and action plan on weekly leadership meeting agenda
- Feedback from EHCP reviews where student voice is captured
- Interim reports from students and their placement mentor
- Celebration events to acknowledge business links and student achievement
